- I can find similarities and differences between plants and animals. (Y1 children only)

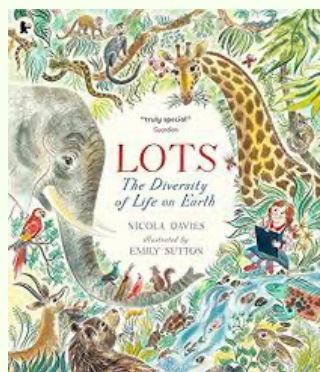

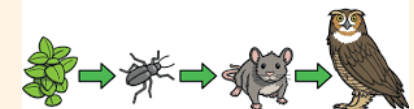

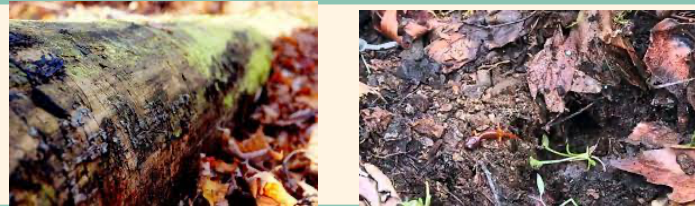

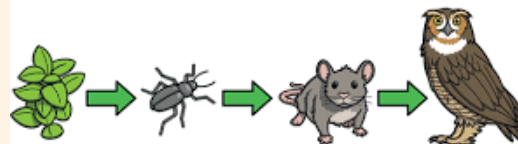
