What do I know ?



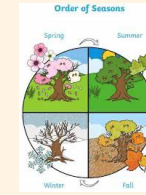
- I know the four seasons in a year.

The four parts of the year split by the change in weather.

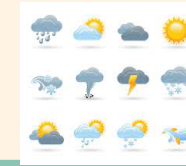
Gems of knowledge

Sunrise



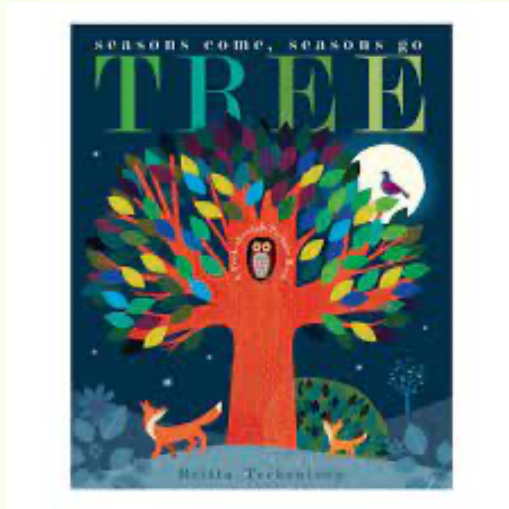
When the sun first appears in the morning.

Sunset

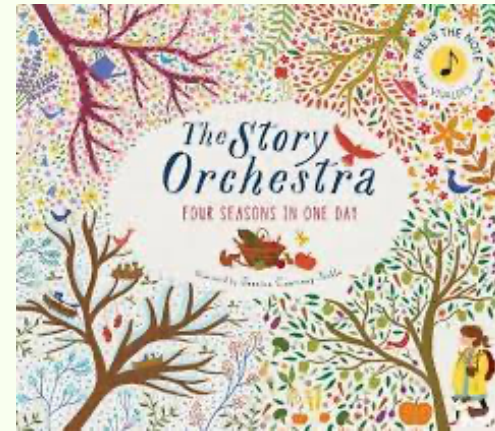


When the sun disappears in the sky in the evening,
