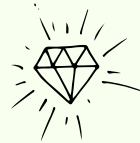


What do I know ?

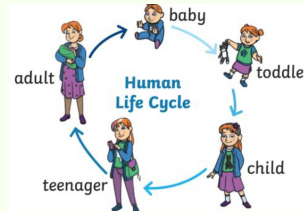


- I can name different body parts. (Y1)

- I will learn that animals have offspring which grow into adults. Some animals give birth to live young. Some animals lay eggs which their young hatch from.



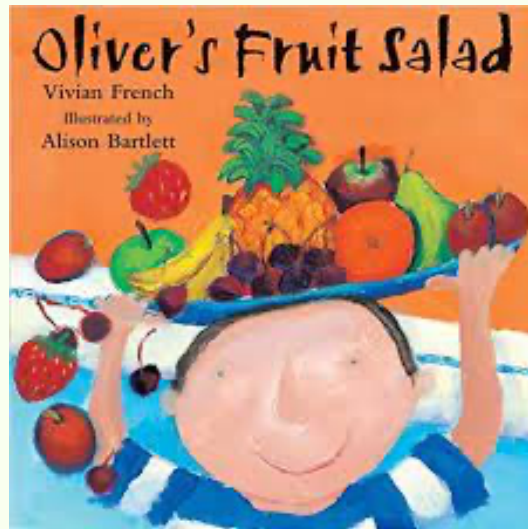
How will I work like a Scientist?



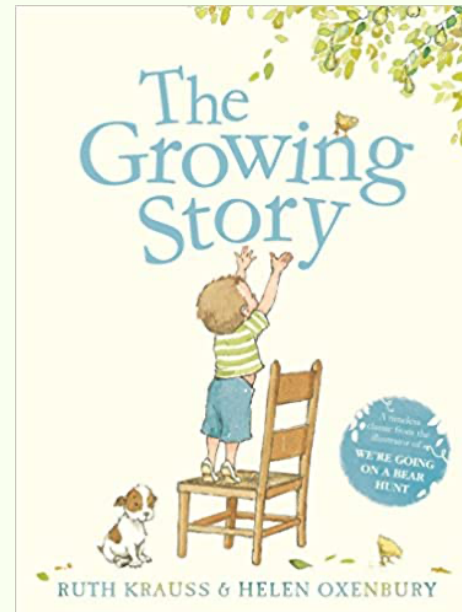
- I will ask simple questions.
