Vocabulary

animation	When lots of pictures are shown quickly one after another to make it look like something is moving
motion	The action of something moving from one place to another
frame	A single picture in a series that, when put together, creates the movement in an animation
storyboard	A plan made up of pictures that show what will happen step by step in your animation or movie
onion-skinning	A tool that shows see-through images of previous frames, helping you see how things are moving as you animate
edit	When you change or fix parts of your animation

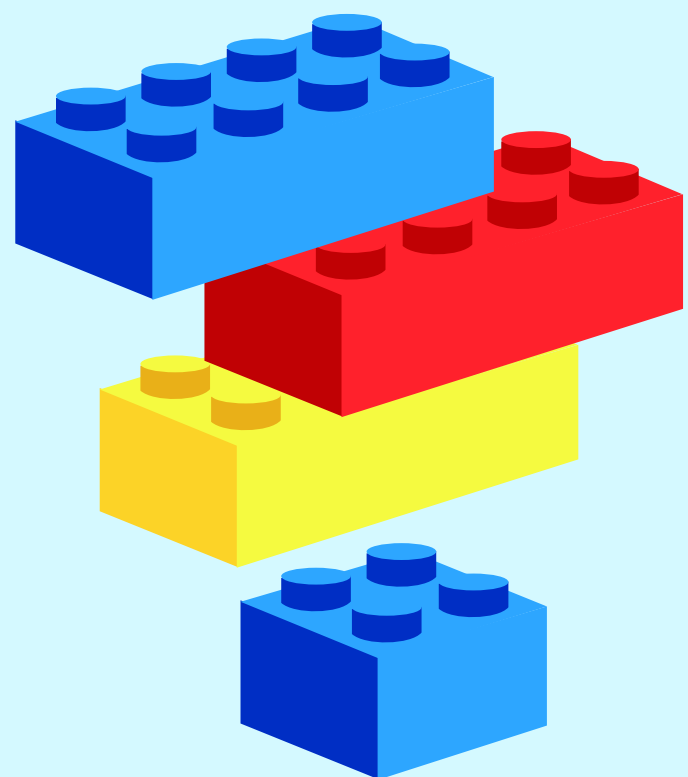

Building Blocks to E-Safety



E-Safety Tips

- Ask before sharing – Always get permission from a parent or teacher before posting your animations online.
- Keep personal info private – Don't include your name, address, or school in your animations or profiles.
- Use safe apps – Only download apps that are trusted and approved by an adult.
- Be careful with photos – Make sure you don't accidentally take or share pictures of private things while making your animations.
