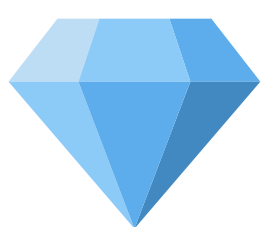
Music Producer

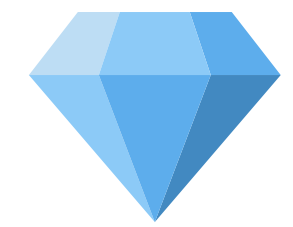


Vocabulary

sprite	A character or object that can be given instructions
command	An instruction given to a computer
motion	When something moves from one place to another
sequence	When things happen in a certain order, step by step
algorithm	A list of instructions that tell you what to do step by step
debug	To fix problems in a set of instructions
backdrop	The picture in the background of a program
costume	Different poses or positions that sprites can have

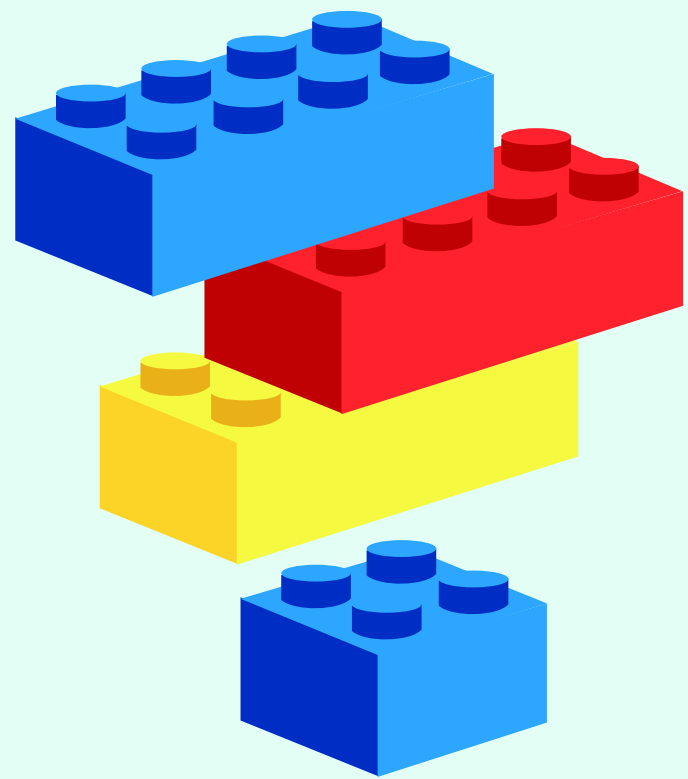

Building Blocks to E-Safety



E-Safety Tips

- Be careful when downloading or installing programs on your computer. Only download programs from trusted sources, like your parents or teachers.
- Be cautious when using computers that are shared with others. Make sure that you close down or log out of everything that you have been using when you have finished.
- Don't click on links you don't recognise. If you click on something you shouldn't have, step away from the computer and tell a trusted adult straight away
