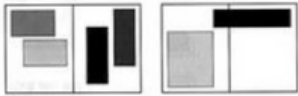
What do I already know how to do?

Arrange



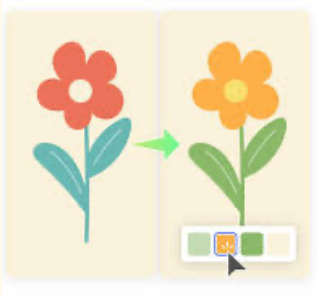
decide where you want each part to go.

Collage



a picture made by gluing different pieces of paper, fabric, or other materials together.

Manipulate



change a piece of art in a creative way, e.g. changing colours, shapes or mixing different images together to make something new.

Media



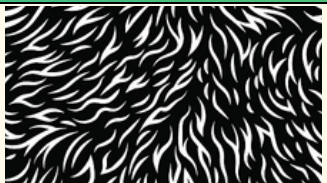
the materials or tools an artist uses to create their artwork. It can be anything from paints, pencils, and clay to digital tools or photography.

Pattern



something that repeats. It can be shapes, colours, or designs that happen over and over in a predictable order.

Texture



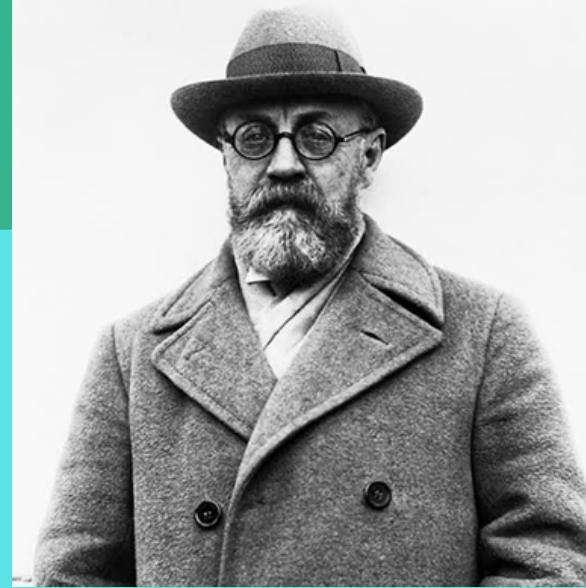
the feel or look of a surface.

Henri Matisse

Henri Matisse was a French artist who loved to paint, draw, and make beautiful art. He was born on December 31, 1869, in a small town in France. When he was young, he didn't know he wanted to be an artist. He studied law to become a lawyer! But one day, when he was poorly, his mom gave him some paints to play with, and he discovered how much he loved making art. Matisse used bright colours and bold shapes in his paintings. He also loved cutting colourful paper to create fun designs, like making a collage. His art made people happy because it was full of life and energy.
