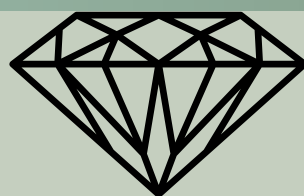

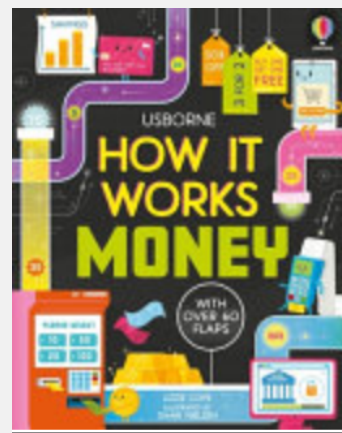
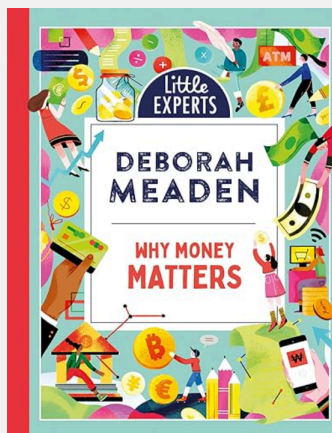
Gems of knowledge

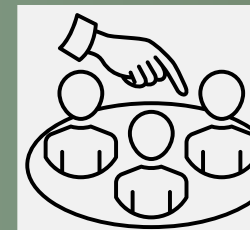

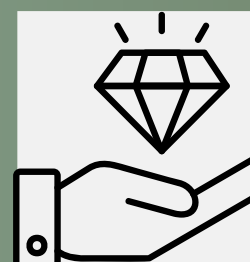
When someone does or says something that makes someone else want to do something.
